### From Dave's Desk

We will be holding an introductory session of classroom training for apprentices that have not yet begun regular classroom training.

We plan to start this training in October. This is scheduled as an 8 week training session that we plan to have every 3 to 4 months, depending on the number of apprentices qualifying. This training will include various types of safety training like powder actuated tools, lift training, tools used in our trade, union and contractor issues, Pro 10/Core 4 certification, 1st aid/CPR certification and OSHA 30 hour construction safety just to name a few.

While most of this training will be conducted by our instructors, we will also have guest speakers from IBEW Local unions, NECA Representatives, Federal Mediation, TEAM representatives, various tool representatives, etc. This is valuable training that should not be delayed until an apprentice is able to start an apprenticeship school year.

### **PLT License Test Prep Class**

As we are ending 2019, the State is preparing to revise the Power Limited Technician license exam in preparation for the 2020 revisions to the National Electrical Code. You may want to apply to take the license exam and test before this process is complete. You can apply online through the State's website of <a href="https://www.dli.mn.gov">www.dli.mn.gov</a>. Make sure you attach all the appropriate documentation needed for approval.

Once you have been *approved by the State to take the license exam*, you have a maximum of 1 year to test. If you don't test within that timeframe, you will need to reapply and receive approval again.

If you have been approved to test, we encourage you to take our license test prep class. For the best test results, you should schedule your test within 3 weeks after completing our course.

The fee for this course is \$125.00. You will need a NEC 2017 Code Book. You are not required to purchase this book from us but you will need it for class. The cost for this book is \$95 if you purchase it from us.

The class is being restructured so dates have not been determined yet. Watch our website. Dates will be listed in our Continuing Education Calendar. This is a 24 hour class with homework assignments. To get the most out of this class, plan to attend all dates.

Come to class prepared, approved by the State to take the license exam, alert and ready to learn. REGISTER EARLY and let us know if you need a Code book!

# Unlicensed Registration Continuing Education Classes

The State will not grant you credit for taking the same 8 hour classe twice within the same renewal period. Keep this in mind when registering.
